Our 4-H meat dog project helps youth learn about dog breeds, health care, production, management, showmanship, marketing, and careers in the dog meat industry. They'll learn principles of dog science and gain life skills by owning, caring for, and keeping records on one or more head of dog.

Kids will:

- Raise a feeder dog for 6-9 months
- Show the dog at the County Fair
- Auction their dog to the highest bidder for the meat market
- Receive money from auction, minus commission

To those who say this project is traumatizing & "desensitizes kids to violence toward dogs," **we say dogwash.** This program teaches:
